**RESOLUTION** AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A MUNICIPAL WORK ZONE AGREEMENT (MWZA) WITH THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (NHDOT) CONCERNING PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS TO THE BRIDGE CARRYING NH 132 (EAST SIDE DRIVE) OVER I-393, US 4, AND US 202 (NHDOT BRIDGE NUMBER 156/138)

*The City of Concord resolves as follows:*

**WHEREAS,** the NHDOT is proposing certain improvements to the bridge carrying NH 132 (East Side Drive) over I-393, US 4, and US 202 (NHDOT Bridge Number 156/138); and,

**WHEREAS,** with the exception of certain improvements to the City's water infrastructure in the project area, the State of New Hampshire is funding the entire project; and,

**WHEREAS,** prior to proceeding with the project, the State has requested that the City execute a Municipal Work Zone Agreement, which will grant the NHDOT the authority to regulate traffic activity within the project area.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Concord that:

1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a Municipal Work Zone Agreement with the State of New Hampshire Department of Transportation concerning proposed improvements to the bridge carrying NH 132 (East Side Drive) over I-393, US 4, and US 202 (NHDOT Bridge Number 156/138).
2. This resolution shall take effect on date of passage.
