Sewer Main Rehabilitation Project (CIP #91) to support needed sewer repairs/upgrades in conjunction with the FY 2017 Water Main Replacement

Project.

Recommendation

Accept this report recommending using \$25,000 of unexpended funds from the FY2017 Sanitary Sewer Main Rehabilitation Project (CIP #91) to support needed sewer repairs/upgrades in conjunction with the FY 2017 Water Main Replacement Project.

Background

During the installation of the new water main on Community Drive five sanitary sewer manholes had to be replaced due to their poor condition and lack of sufficient cover to reconnect the existing sewer services.

Discussion

There are excess funds available in the 2017 CIP#91 Sewer Replacement Project of Putney and Forest Streets that was recently completed. We recommend using \$25,000 to support the needed repairs to replace five substandard sanitary manholes encountered during the installation of the new water main.

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
