RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION IN AN AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED THIRTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$130,000) AND TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE GRANT PROCEEDS OF ONE HUNDRED THIRTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$130,000) OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT COVID-19 FUNDS (CDBG-CV) FOR THE CONCORD COALITION TO END HOMELESSNESS' EMERGENCY WINTER SHELTER AND RESOURCE CENTER OPERATIONS

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The City of Concord resolves as follows:

- WHEREAS, the New Hampshire Community Development Finance Authority has recently made additional pandemic related federal funds through the Community Development Block Grant program available to NH municipalities; and
- WHEREAS, the City of Concord desires to assist the Concord Coalition to End Homelessness (CCEH) to have access to these funds for programs regarding homeless and housing insecurity; and,
- WHEREAS, CCEH proposes to utilize CDBG-CV funds assist in the operation of their Emergency Winter Shelter (EWS) and Resource Center (RC) for the period December 1, 2025, to June 30, 2026; and,
- WHEREAS, Community Development funds are available through the New Hampshire Community Development Finance Authority, Community Development Block Grant Program Division, to assist such projects; and,
- WHEREAS, this appropriation is for a purpose not included in the adopted budget, therefore, section 37 of the City Charter requires a two-third vote of the City Council.

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Concord that:

1. The sum of\$130,000
be and is hereby appropriated as follows:

CDBG Fund

CCEH Emergency Shelter/Resource Center.....\$130,000

2. Said revenue shall be available as follows:

CCEH Emergency Shelter/Resource Center.....\$130,000

3. The City Council approves this Community Development Block Grant application and hereby authorizes the City Manager to prepare, execute, and submit the necessary documents and to apply for, accept, administer, and spend said CDBG-CV funds for the purposes described herein upon approval by the NH Community Development Finance Authority.
4. Upon approval of the CDBG-CV application, City Manager is authorized to execute any documents which may be necessary to effectuate the CDBG contract and any amendments thereto.
5. This resolution shall take effect upon its passage and grant award.
