Solid Waste Flow Control Ordinance Article 5-8

#### **Recommendation:**

Accept this report and set the attached ordinance amending the Code of Ordinances; Title I, General Code; Chapter 5, Public Works; Article 5-8, Solid Waste, for a public hearing on June 13, 2016.

### **Background:**

Concord's Solid Waste Operations are regulated by under Title I, Chapter 5 of the City's Code of Ordinances. Article 5-8 administers and regulates commercial collection, hauling and disposal of the City's solid waste through flow control.

#### Discussion:

Amendments to Article 5-8 include defining certain terms under the Article to be consistent with State law and City of Concord practices and procedures relative to the licensure and enforcement of commercial collection, hauling and disposal of the City's solid waste.

With respect to the commercial disposal of the City's solid waste, in addition to the City's Allenstown Transfer Station Designated Facility located at 104 River Road, Allenstown, New Hampshire, 03275, this Ordinance adds the Bestway Transfer Station as a Designated Facility, located at 43 Industrial Drive, Belmont, New Hampshire 03220. The Belmont Transfer Station provides Licensed Haulers with an additional disposal option to the Allenstown Transfer Station. Licensed Haulers who elect to use this alternative site would be subject to an additional \$2.00/ton host fee assessed by the Town of Belmont.
