RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPLY FOR A GRANT FOR UP TO TWO MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$2,850,000) WITH THE NEW HAMPSHIRE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (NHDOT), BUREAU OF AERONAUTICS, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING PHASE 1&2 REHABILITATION OF 5000 FEET OF TAXIWAY A, CRACK SEALING AND MARKING RUNWAYS 17/35 AND 12/30 AND OBSTRUCTION REMOVAL.

The City of Concord resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, the City of Concord is eligible to apply and receive funding for the construction of the rehabilitation, lighting and marking for Taxiway A and crack sealing and marking Runways 17/35 and 12/30 as described in the FY 2018 and 2019 Capital Improvement Program and Budget as project #468; and

WHEREAS, obstructions in need of removal were identified on airport property by NHDOT as part of the annual 2017 airport inspection; and

WHEREAS, on April 10, 2017, Resolution 8987 authorized the City Manager to apply for a grant in the amount of \$1,314,000 for the Construction of Phase I of the Taxiway A Reconstruction Project; and

WHEREAS, on August 14, 2017, Resolution 9028 appropriated the amount of \$1,468,980 for the construction of Phase I of the Taxiway A Reconstruction Project; and

WHEREAS, in the fall of 2017, Federal Aviation Administration notified NHDOT that the City's grant application for the reconstruction of Taxiway A was not approved; and

WHEREAS, the City is now seeking to apply for grant funding for Phase 1 and 2 and should the City's application for this purpose be accepted, project funding would be allocated as follows; \$2,565,000 (90%) Federal share, \$142,500 (5%) State and \$142,500 (5%) City share; and

WHEREAS, the Phase II construction of Taxiway A rehabilitation is programmed in FY2019 of the Capital Improvement Program and Budget; and

WHEREAS, the Airport Advisory Committee recommends that the City Council approve this grant application and acceptance; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Concord that:

1. The City Council has authorized the City Manager to submit the necessary grant application to the NHDOT, Bureau of Aeronautics.

2. This resolution shall take effect upon its passage.
