Hi Dan,

I live at 32 Tallant Rd, which is a dirt Rd. The conditions of the road are awful. We have lived there for about 4 years now, but owned the property about 7 years. It seems like it was paved years ago, and then converted to a dirt road at some point. When we were first living here the upkeep would be to re-grade the road a couple of times a year by bringing in dirt. It would hold up several months and be fine. Now it seems that they just scrape the road down and it becomes washed out again within weeks. I would like to see about getting the road paved, as the road now is about impassable, three weeks after it was serviced.

Additionally, last winter we had a fire at our house, and emergency vehicles were unable to easily get to our house as they had to drive down an additional half mile to turn around due to the sharp angle of the turn. This also makes it impossible for a bus to make it up our road...our daughter was almost hit by a driver going through a bus stop sign last fall because of where the bus has to stop. We have since had to move the bus stop down to the same turn around the fire trucks used a half mile away. I would like to see about widening the turn in for the road so that an emergency vehicle is easily able to access the houses on the road.

I would like to meet with you and show you these two issues for you to bring back to city planning. I know there was a recent grant for paving roads and would like to see this work included in these projects. We certainly do not see a decreased tax rate due to this road, so I would expect to have the same roads as anyone else paying Concord taxes.
