RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF FIFTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$55,000.00) IN FUNDING FROM THE ADVERSE CHILDHOOD EXPERIENCE RESPONSE TEAM (ACERT) PROGRAM ADMINISTERED THROUGH THE MERRIMACK COUNTY CHILD ADVOCACY CENTER, FUNDS DESIGNATED FOR OVERTIME EXPENSES INCURRED BY THE POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR ACERT PROGRAM ACTIVITIES

The City of Concord resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, the Concord Police Department has played an integral role in the development of an Adverse Childhood Experience Response Team Program in the Concord area, which is designed to serve and offer resources to children who have been exposed to violence; and

WHEREAS, the Concord ACERT Program will be administered by the Merrimack County Child Advocacy Center which has received funding through the Granite United Way; and

WHEREAS, the Concord Police Department desires to utilize this funding through the Merrimack County Child Advocacy Center for reimbursement of overtime costs associated with the Department's participation in ACERT activities in assisting children exposed to violence; and

WHEREAS, there is no financial match required for this program; and

WHEREAS, this appropriation is for a purpose not included in the Fiscal Year 2020 adopted budget, therefore Section 37 of the City Charter requires a two-thirds vote of the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of City of Concord that:

1. The sum of\$55,000.00
be and is hereby appropriated as follows:

Miscellaneous Special Revenue Fund
Overtime and Benefits.....\$55,000.00

2. Revenue to meet said appropriation shall be provided from the following source:
