RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUND PROJECT AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE DEPARTMENT **OF RESOURCES AND ECONOMIC** DEVELOPMENT FOR A LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUND GRANT WHICH THE CITY HAS BEEN AWARDED FOR THE AMOUNT OF TWO HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS TO BE USED FOR THE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF A PORTION OF THE MERRIMACK RIVER GREENWAY TRAIL PROJECT (CIP 543)

The City of Concord resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, this project is programmed in the FY 2016 Capital Improvement Program and

Budget as CIP Project #543; and

the Land and Water Conservation Fund Project agreement will allow the NH WHEREAS,

Department of Resources and Economic Development to administer the project

for the US Department of the Interior, National Parks Service.

WHEREAS, the project funding for this portion of the Merrimack River Greenway Trail

design and construction will be up to \$200,000 and allocated as follows: up to

\$100,000 (1/2) LWCF share and up to \$100,000 (1/2) City share; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Concord that:

- 1) The City Council has authorized the City Manager to enter into a Land and Water Conservation Fund Project Agreement with the State Of New Hampshire Department of Resources and Economic Development.
- 2) This resolution shall take effect upon its passage.
