RE: Public Safety Board Appointment

I propose the appointment of the following individual to the Public Safety Board for a two-year term expiring December 31, 2024.

In accordance with Section 18 of the City Council Rules, this proposed appointment is being distributed to City Council as information in advance of formal action at the December 12, 2022 City Council meeting. Accordingly, I ask for suspension of the rules so that this nomination may be affirmed at the December 12, 2022 City Council meeting.

Councilor Grady Sexton:

I am writing in regard to the open position for a public member on the Concord Public Safety Board. I have been a resident of Concord for the past 12 years and believe that my combination of background, knowledge and experience makes me a strong candidate to serve.

I moved to Concord in 2010 to accept a job at Elevare Communications, then a subsidiary of the law firm Gallagher, Callahan and Gartrell. While my main focus was on energy policy, I provided government relations services to a wide range of clients including a victims' rights and criminal justice reform-focused organization. Volunteer boards and commissions include work on the Concord, New Hampshire Redistricting Committee (2021) and the New Hampshire State Juvenile Parole Board (2018-present). The latter position focuses on determination of placement, treatment and rehabilitation for juvenile offenders to prevent recidivism.

I currently serve as Administrator of The Site Evaluation Committee – chief administrative officer for permitting, oversight and enforcement of compliance for energy facilities in the state. This position requires inter-governmental project management and coordination between state agencies including Safety, Transportation, Environmental Services and The Department of Justice.
