RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A MUNICIPAL WORK ZONE AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (NHDOT), FOR TRAFFIC CONTROL ON CITY STREETS RELATED TO STATE PROJECT 40766, I-89 PAVEMENT RESURFACING PROJECT.

The City of Concord resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, the New Hampshire Department of Transportation (NHDOT) will be resurfacing Interstate 89 from MM 0.0 (Bow) to MM 8.2 (Hopkinton) including crack sealing ramps at Exit 1, 3, and 4, inlaying ramps at Exit 2 and Exit 5 NB off ramp, replacing and repairing guardrail as needed, and resurfacing two shared use paths paralleling I-89 from the Bow Park & Ride to Valley Road in Bow, and Silk Farm Road to Stickney Hill Road in Concord; and

WHEREAS, the State Legislature has delegated the Commissioner of NHDOT with full authority to control traffic in highway/bridge construction work zones on Class I, II, and III highways; RSA 228:21, 236:1, and 228:37; and

WHEREAS, the DOT will be responsible for the management and operation of the interstate highway and shared use path throughout the duration of the construction of the project including the authority to determine the most appropriate way to control traffic within the construction work zone limits, including nighttime I-89 ramp closures at: 1) the I-93 SB off ramp to I-89 NB for which traffic will be redirected off I-93 SB at Exit 12 and onto NH 3A to the I-89 entrance, and 2) Exit 2 for which traffic will be redirected to Exits 1 and 3, and

WHEREAS, the City of Concord agrees to delegate the authority to the DOT Commissioner for all control of traffic within the construction work zone as required;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Concord that:

1. The City Council has authorized the City Manager to enter into a municipal work zone agreement with the New Hampshire Department of Transportation for all traffic control including streets under Concord control for the completion of the pavement resurfacing project on Interstate 89, and the pavement resurfacing project on the shared use path adjacent to I-89, both part of the BOW-HOPKINTON 40766 project.
