### Background

1. Funds are requested to be expended under the authority established pursuant to Resolution #8120, adopted December 10, 2007.
2. The purpose of these funds as stated above is a condition of a Merrimack County Superior Court disposition and is consistent with and presents no conflict or obstacle to the accomplishment of City Council goals, the code of ordinances, or the operating functions of the department.
4. No City match is required.
5. Funds have already been received by the City.

### Discussion

On July 10, 2018 the Merrimack County Superior Court issued an order in docket #217-2018-CV-0038 – Defendant: J. Folsom and R. Watterson. The charges associated with this case involve the sale of illegal drugs. The Concord Police Department Drug Enforcement Unit assisted the NH Attorney General’s Drug Task Force during this investigation which resulted in the seizure of US currency. The State of NH completed forfeiture proceedings against the defendants for this currency. As a result of these forfeiture proceedings, the Concord Police Department received a total of \$4,393.70. By statute, these funds are designated to be utilized in the furtherance of illegal drug investigations. This amount represents a percentage of the seized US currency in this case, which was split amongst the agencies involved in the investigation.
