RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF SIXTY-SEVEN THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN DOLLARS (\$67,637) TO CONTINUE THE WORK OF REDUCING ENERGY USAGE AT THE HALL STREET WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT (CIP #104) AND ACCEPTING THE SUM OF SIXTY-SEVEN THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN DOLLARS (\$67,637) FROM THE UNITIL NHSAVES ENERGY EFFICIENCY INCENTIVE REBATE PROGRAM FOR THIS PURPOSE

The City of Concord resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, in December of 2021, the department received notification from Unitil (NHSAVES) of a rebate in the amount of \$67,637 for the recent replacement of the plant’s aeration blower with energy efficient equipment; and

WHEREAS, the aeration blower replacement project (CIP #104) was completed as part of the Wastewater Division’s ongoing energy efficiency initiative originally established and funded by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the department has identified other energy saving projects that could be accomplished by reinvesting these funds in the Lighting Upgrades (CIP #104); and

WHEREAS, this appropriation is for a purpose for which funds were not included in the Fiscal Year 2022 adopted budget, therefore Section 37 of the City Charter requires a two-thirds vote of the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Concord that:

- 1) The sum of \$67,637
be and is hereby appropriated as follows:

Wastewater Capital Project Fund
Lighting Upgrades (CIP #104)..... \$67,637

- 2) Revenue to meet said appropriation shall be provided from the following sources:

Wastewater Capital Project Fund
Unitil (NHSAVES) rebate program..... \$67,637

- 3) Sums as appropriated shall be expended under the direction of the City Manager.

- 4) This resolution shall take effect upon its passage.
