SUBJECT: Municipal Work Zone Agreement with NHDOT

Recommendation:

Accept this report authorizing the City Manager to enter into a Municipal Work Zone Agreement with the New Hampshire Department of Transportation (NHDOT) for its resurfacing of NH Route 106 from U.S Route 3 in Pembroke to NH Route 9 in Concord.

Background

NHDOT recently informed the City that the Department will be resurfacing NH Route 106 from just north of U.S. Route 3 in Pembroke to just south of NH Route 9 in Concord. Work is expected to occur in the spring of 2019 with completion expected in the fall of 2019. City Engineering staff will be invited to the pre-construction meeting.

Discussion

As part of their protocol, NHDOT requests that municipalities enter into Municipal Work Zone Agreements that stipulate that the Department will be responsible for the management and operation of the highway during construction, including the authority to determine the most appropriate way to control traffic within the construction work zone.
