AN ORDINANCE amending the CODE OF ORDINANCES, Title I, General Code; Chapter 14, Morals and Conduct

The City of Concord ordains as follows:

SECTION I: Amend the CODE OF ORDINANCES, Title I, General Code; Chapter 14, Morals and Conduct, by amending Section 14-5-5 Exceptions, as follows:

14-5-5 Exceptions.

~~[The provisions of Sections 14-5-2 and 14-5-3 shall not apply to commercial uses licensed by the City.]~~

A. Social Districts

i. The provisions of Sections 14-5-2 and 14-5-3 shall not apply within Social Districts as defined by RSA 178:33, II, that have been established by the City Council.

ii. The City Council may vote to establish a Social District and approve a management and maintenance plan for a district in conformance with the requirements of RSA 178:35 and in accordance with the following procedure:

- a. The Code Administration office shall establish a Social District application form and enforcement policy for review and approval by the City Council prior to implementation of any Social Districts under this section;***
- b. Social District applications shall be submitted to the Public Safety Advisory Board for review and public input prior to any action by the City Council. The Public Safety Advisory Board shall make a recommendation to the City Council on the disposition of the application.***

B. Commercial Uses

i. The provisions of Sections 14-5-2 and 14-5-3 shall not apply to commercial uses licensed by the City.

SECTION II: This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage.
