I'm wondering if there's something we can do about the crosswalk at Mountain Rd. and Fernald St. This morning I counted 12 cars that blew past the crosswalk without slowing as a father and his kindergartener tried to cross the street to get to the bus stop on Mountain Rd. There is a sign at the crosswalk reminding drivers that it's state law to yield to pedestrians in the crosswalk but it has no effect. Perhaps a set of flashing lights when a pedestrian is present would get motorists' attention? People drive on Mountain Rd. at speeds well above the speed limit. The high speeds coupled with a disregard for the crosswalk creates a risk for pedestrians.
