WHEREAS, Families in Transition (FIT) is a homelessness and housing provider with a

mission to prevent and break the cycle of homelessness through their services, which includes two low-income housing properties in Concord

located at 9 Odd Fellows Avenue and 5 Market Lane; and

WHEREAS, FIT desires to secure Community Development Block Grant funds to

renovate underutilized commercial space at the 2 above referenced properties and create a total of 4 new affordable residential housing units;

and

WHEREAS, FIT seeks assistance with financing of the construction of these

improvements; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Concord desires to secure Supportive Housing Facility

Community Development Block Grant Funds to support construction of expanded affordable housing opportunities within the community; and,

WHEREAS, Community Development funds are available through the New Hampshire

Community Development Finance Authority, Community Development

Block Grant Program Division, to assist such projects; and,

WHEREAS, this appropriation is for a purpose not included in the 2026 adopted budget,
