AN ORDINANCE amending the CODE OF ORDINANCES; Title II, Traffic Code; Chapter 18, Parking, Article 18-3, Parking Meters and Schedule X.

The City of Concord ordains as follows:

SECTION I: Amend the CODE OF ORDINANCES; Title II, Traffic Code; Chapter 18, Parking, Article 18-3, Parking Meters, Section 18-3-4, Location of Parking Meters, by adding and removing the following locations to Schedule X, as follows:
