The Concord Farmers Market Association is asking that Capitol Street be closed to vehicular traffic (from Green St. to No. State St.), for the hours of 6:00 am until 1:00 pm on Saturday's only, starting May 6, to Oct 28. As always, all licenses, permits, and necessary insurances will be renewed and in place by the first of May. We will continue to work closely with the Concord Code Administration and Concord Police Department to ensure a safe, well run, market.

2017 will be our nineteenth year on Capitol Street and over 40 years in Concord.

In 2016, with the return of the market to Capitol Street and construction moving to the south end of Main Street, the market felt like we had come home. The ongoing work on the Capitol dome did not interfere with the market and we all enjoyed a successful marketing season. We look forward to 2017 with a new vibrant Main Street, a shiny, glowing State House and hopefully the continuation of Saturday tours of our historic State House.
