The City of Co	ncord resolves as follows:
WHEREAS,	the City of Concord is one of 23 qualifying subdivisions in New Hampshire to share in the Opioid Litigation Settlement Fund Distribution; and
WHEREAS,	this settlement relates to State of New Hampshire v McKinsey & Company Inc. (Merrimack County 217-2021-CV-0073); and
WHEREAS,	the City will receive a portion of the 15% distribution amount of \$782,028.75 that is designated to be distributed to those political subdivisions in accordance with RSA 126-A:83, II; and
WHEREAS,	the City is scheduled to receive a payment in the amount of \$24,960.24; and
WHEREAS,	with this payment, the City will have received a total of \$63,211.87 to date; and
WHEREAS,	this appropriation is for a purpose for which funding was not included in the Fiscal Year 2023 adopted budget, therefore Section 37 of the City Charter requires a two-thirds vote of the City Council.
NOW, THERE	FORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Concord that
