I'm wondering if we need to hold a bake sale or car wash to raise some money for the city of Concord to buy some street paint? □ Everywhere I travel in Concord I find barely visible crosswalks, center lines, stop bars, etc. I realize that the road paint of today is less durable than in years past, but this is ridiculous. And, most of these areas were poorly painted last year too, so I know it's not all from winter plowing. Franklin Street is a notable exception. Does the city have a new policy regarding street paint?

On another note, I feel it is time for something to be done about the speeding traffic on Franklin Street.
