**RESOLUTION** AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A MUNICIPAL WORK ZONE AGREEMENT (MWZA) WITH THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (NHDOT) CONCERNING PROPOSED PAVEMENT IMPROVEMENTS ALONG NH ROUTE 106 (SHEEP DAVIS ROAD) AND US ROUTE 3 (MANCHESTER STREET)

*The City of Concord resolves as follows:*

**WHEREAS**, the NHDOT is proposing certain pavement improvements along NH Route 106 (Sheep Davis Road) and US Route 3 (Manchester Street) in Concord; and,

**WHEREAS**, the State of New Hampshire is funding the entire project; and,

**WHEREAS**, prior to proceeding with the project, the State has requested that the City execute a Municipal Work Zone Agreement, which will grant the NHDOT the authority to regulate traffic activity within the project area.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Concord that:

1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a Municipal Work Zone Agreement with the State of New Hampshire Department of Transportation concerning proposed pavement improvements along NH Route 106 (Sheep Davis Road) and US Route 3 (Manchester Street) in Concord.
2. This resolution shall take effect on date of passage.
