RESOLUTION	APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF TWENTY-FOUR THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED SIXTY DOLLARS AND TWENTY-FIVE CENTS (\$24,960.25) AS A TRANSFER TO THE OPIOID ABATEMENT RESERVE AND ACCEPTING THE SUM OF TWENTY-FOUR THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED SIXTY DOLLARS AND TWENTY-FIVE CENTS (\$24,960.25) IN OPIOID LITIGATION SETTLEMENT FUNDS FOR THIS PURPOSE
The City of Concord resolves as follows:	
WHEREAS,	the City of Concord is one of 23 qualifying subdivisions in New Hampshire to share in the Opioid Litigation Settlement Fund Distribution; and
WHEREAS,	this settlement relates to State of New Hampshire v McKinsey & Company Inc. (Merrimack County 217-2021-CV-0073); and
WHEREAS,	the City will receive a portion of the 15% distribution that is designated to those political subdivisions in accordance with RSA 126-A:83, II; and
WHEREAS,	the City received a payment in the amount of \$24,960.25 on August 29, 2023; and
WHEREAS,	with this payment, the City will have received a total of \$243,952.46 to date; and
WHEREAS,	this appropriation is for a purpose for which funding was not included in the Fiscal Year 2024 adopted budget, therefore Section 37 of the City Charter requires a two-thirds vote of the City Council.
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Concord that:	
	The sum of\$24,960.25 be and is hereby appropriated as follows:
	General Fund Fransfer Out to Trust\$24,960.25
2. F	Revenue to meet said appropriation shall be provided from the following source:
