WHEREAS,	the State of New Hampshire has made available a program called the State Homeland Security Program (SHSP) Critical Infrastructure — Water Related Catastrophe related grant for municipalities to receive funding for the purpose of obtaining critically needed water rescue equipment; and
WHEREAS,	approval to apply for these grants was secured at the August 8 th , 2022 City Council meeting; and
WHEREAS,	the City of Concord has applied and has been accepted for these grants; and
WHEREAS,	there is no financial match required for this grant program; and
WHEREAS,	the City of Concord could substantially benefit from this equipment; and
WHEREAS,	this appropriation is for a purpose for which funding was not included in the Fiscal Year
