RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE TERMS OF BOTH A 2020 AND A 2021 CRITICAL INFRASTRUCTURE/WATER-RELATED CATASTROPHE EQUIPMENT GRANT, APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$25,000) IN THE FIRE/NH DEPT OF SAFETY GRANTS AND DONATIONS PROJECT FOR THE PURCHASE OF WATER RESCUE AND RELATED EQUIPMENT, AND ACCEPTING THE SUM OF TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$25,000) IN NH DEPARTMENT OF SAFETY STATE HOMELAND SECURITY PROGRAM FUNDING FOR THIS PURPOSE

The City of Concord resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, the State of New Hampshire has made available a program called the State Homeland Security Program (SHSP) Critical Infrastructure – Water Related Catastrophe related grant for municipalities to receive funding for the purpose of obtaining critically needed water rescue equipment; and

WHEREAS, approval to apply for these grants was secured at the August 8th, 2022 City Council meeting; and

WHEREAS, the City of Concord has applied and has been accepted for these grants; and

WHEREAS, there is no financial match required for this grant program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Concord could substantially benefit from this equipment; and

WHEREAS, this appropriation is for a purpose for which funding was not included in the Fiscal Year 2023 adopted budget, therefore section 37 of the City Charter requires a two-thirds vote of the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Concord that:

1. The sum of\$25,000
be and is hereby appropriated as follows:

Grants and Donations Fund

Fire/NH Dept of Safety project.....\$25,000

2. Revenue to meet said appropriation shall be provided from the following source:

Grants and Donations Fund

NH Department of Safety State Homeland Security Program funds\$25,000

3. Sums as appropriated shall be expended under the direction of the City Manager.

4. The resolution shall take effect upon its passage.
