SUBJECT: Report from the Interim Fire Chief on Reimbursements from the Federal Emergency Management Agency

Recommendation

Accept and appropriate the amount of forty thousand five hundred sixty-five dollars and thirty-nine cents (\$40,565.39) of reimbursement for costs associated with the deployment of Fire Department personnel to areas of the country impacted by natural disasters.

Background

During calendar year 2019, the Department provided personnel to support areas of the country impacted by hurricanes and flooding as part of Massachusetts Task Force One, an urban search and rescue team which functions under the auspices of the Federal Emergency Management Agency. The federal government reimburses local governments for all costs associated with the deployment of personnel, including overtime and backfill. Reimbursement in the amount of \$40,565.39 was requested and has been received.

Discussion

The Fire Department will advise the City Council of any future activity related to the deployment of personnel by the Federal Emergency Management Agency.
