RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ACQUISITION OF LAND NORTH OF CURRIER ROAD FOR CONSERVATION PURPOSES AND AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF UP TO THIRTY-FIVE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$35,500) FROM THE CONSERVATION FUND FOR THIS PURPOSE. AS RECOMMENDED BY THE CONSERVATION COMMISSION

The City of Concord resolves as follows;

- WHEREAS, on April 12, 2004 the City adopted the provisions of RSA 36-A, re-establishing the Concord Conservation Commission with the power to acquire in the name of the city, subject to the approval of the local governing body, by gift, purchase, grant, bequest, devise, lease, or otherwise, the fee in such land or water rights, or any lesser interest, development right, easement, covenant, or other contractual right including conveyances with conditions, limitations or reversions, as may be necessary to acquire, maintain, improve, protect, or limit the future use of or otherwise conserve and properly utilize open spaces and other land and water areas within the city; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) included a recommendation to purchase land or easements for the purposes as provided in RSA 36-A noted as CIP # 352; and
- **WHEREAS,** the property is located within the Conservation Focus Area identified as "Currier Road" in the 2017 Conservation Open Space Plan; and
- WHEREAS, the West End Farm Trail crosses through the property; and
- WHEREAS, the Conservation Commission, under the provision of RSA 36-A, conducted a public hearing on February 12, 2020, after which the Conservation Commission members voted unanimously in the affirmative to exercise their authority with regard to obtaining the parcel legally described as: Tax Map 99 Block 2 Lot 8, consisting of approximately 31 acres; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Conservation Commission intends to pay \$35,500 for the above-cited parcel using funds available in the Conservation Fund; and
- **WHEREAS**, this appropriation is for a purpose not included in the Fiscal Year 2020 adopted budget; therefore Section 37 of the City Charter requires a two-thirds vote of the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Concord that:

- 1) The City Manager be authorized to execute the Warranty Deed acquiring the parcel as described above, at a cost to the City not to exceed \$35,500 is hereby approved.
