Hi Matt,

I hope all is well with you. I'm so sorry about the passing of Kathleen Murphy and send condolences to her family, the school board, and all of the school district staff. I know how much she loved the opening of school each August and how sad the first day must have been for all of you.

Both yesterday and today there have been serious issues with the traffic at school dismissal time. Yesterday we returned from shopping about 2.52. I was surprised that there was still a long line of cars. We waited patiently in the right hand lane for over 5 minutes until we were opposite our driveway (instead of making a dangerous third lane as many cars were still leaving MillBrook) Just as Steve began to turn into our driveway, a parent in a van came out of nowhere to the left of us and caused a collision. Fortunately, we weren't injured nor was she or her passenger. There was some car damage - mostly to her van. She lives further down So Curtisville well past the schools, but chose not to wait in the traffic line. A police officer came to evaluate the accident etc, and I mentioned the

dangerous situation over here. He has been here a few times watching the 4 way stop - another issue.

This afternoon I went out front and watched the pick up scenario. Vehicles were traveling way too fast. A third lane of traffic was created causing a major problem - especially when a school bus was heading down toward the school and a large UPS truck was coming up from down beyond the schools. The UPS truck had to drive up practically onto our neighbor's lawn. Traffic was backed up well beyond the stop signs. A car was blocking Dominique and the crossing guard had to speak to that driver, who then backed up and blocked the crosswalk! I'm not sure what steps can be taken to help with this issue, but something needs to be done before there's a tragic accident. Perhaps you or the acting Superintendent can ask Ms.Scarpati and Mr.Rapucci to send something on Parent Square urging parents to slow down, stay to the right, and be patient?!

Anyway, I apologize for this lengthy message, but it's an important situation. Feel free to share this with administration if needed. Thank you in advance for any assistance. You are welcome to watch from our front lawn any afternoon next week. Thanks for all you do. I'm attaching a few pics. Wish I had captured the bus vs UPS scene.
