RE: Street Closure Request

Mayor Bouley and Honorable City Councilors:

The New Hampshire Law Enforcement Officers' Memorial Committee will hold the 25th Annual Memorial Ceremony on Friday, May 19, 2017. Because it is the 25th anniversary of the Memorial, we would like to host a candlelight vigil on September 29, 2017 beginning at 6:00 pm. The vigil will be held on the southeast corner of the Legislative Office Building on the corner of Capitol and North State Streets.

The location of the Memorial on the corner of Capitol and North Main Streets makes it impossible to conduct the Annual Memorial Ceremony without closing some City of Concord streets. On behalf of the Memorial Committee, we would respectfully request permission from the City of Concord, City Council, and Police Department for the following street closures:

- Capitol Street from Green Street to North State Street

The Memorial Vigil is scheduled to begin at 6:00 pm. If the requested street closures are granted, the Committee recommends the time of the closure should be from 3:00 pm – 8:00 pm. This will provide sufficient time for closing the streets to prevent parking in the designated area, set up of the event, the event, and subsequent clean-up.

Our annual event has been well received and successful and I am not aware of any problems or complaints from the residents or visitors to the City of Concord. Permit applications have been submitted to the State of New Hampshire, Bureau of General Services and to Code Administration at the City of Concord.
