RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF TWELVE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$12,750) FOR THE INSTALLATION OF WATER FOR THE DOG PARK AT TERRILL PARK (CIP #59) AND ACCEPTING THE SUM OF TWELVE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$12,750) FROM THE CONCORD ROTARY CLUB FOR THIS PURPOSE

The City of Concord resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, the City Council already has already funded the work for the new dog park and Merrimack River Greenway Trail; and

WHEREAS, the City of Concord would like to add the \$12,750 to the already approved work (FY20 CIP#59) to allow the city to install a water line to the dog park that will allow the city to have a dog water fountain at Terrill Park; and

WHEREAS, the City of Concord owns the land and has this project listed in the City’s Capital Improvement Plan (CIP #59); and

WHEREAS, this appropriation is for a purpose not included in the Fiscal Year 2022 adopted budget, therefore section 37 of the City Charter requires a two-thirds vote of the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Concord that:

1. The sum of\$12,750
 be and is hereby appropriated as follows:

General Capital Project Fund
 Terrill Park (CIP #59)\$12,750

2. Revenue to meet said appropriation shall be provided from the following source:

General Capital Project Fund
 Concord Rotary Club donation\$12,750

3. Sums as appropriated shall be expended under the direction of the City Manager.
4. This resolution shall take effect upon its passage.
