The City of Concord resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, the Concord Police Department has received notification from the New Hampshire Highway Safety Agency that we have been awarded a grant in the amount of up to ten thousand dollars (\$10,000); and

WHEREAS, the Concord City Council approved Resolution #8906, adopted April 11, 2016, at their regular meeting authorizing the City Manager to apply for the above grant; and

WHEREAS, these funds have been designated by the New Hampshire Highway Safety Agency to be applied towards Distracted Driving Enforcement Patrols, and the Concord Police Department desires to conduct such patrols; and

WHEREAS, there is an in-kind match by the City in the amount of \$2,500 required for accepting these funds; and

WHEREAS, this match will be accounted for through administrative costs and equipment costs incurred by the Department through the life of the grant; and

WHEREAS, this appropriation is for a purpose not included in the adopted budget, therefore section 37 of the City Charter requires a two-thirds vote of the City Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of City of Concord that:

1. The sum of\$10,000.00
be and is hereby appropriated as follows:

Miscellaneous Special Revenue Fund
Police Overtime and Benefits.....\$10,000.00
