
I have confirmed with the Concord Department of Parks and Recreation that their program fee schedule is not set by them, but by the Concord City Council. I am, therefore, enlisting your support to revise the indoor pickle ball fee schedule as follows:

Concord residents 65 years of age or older – no fee
Concord residents under 65 years of age - \$2.00 per session
Non-Concord residents of all ages - \$3.00 per session

Currently, Concord residents of any age pay \$3.00 per session (as well, of course, as their annual city taxes) Non-Concord residents pay \$4.00 per session. Pickle ball participants are on their own with no instructor, we provide our own paddles, and would gladly assist in the cost of replacing the pickle balls and/or nets as needed. Tax-paying Concord residents should enjoy the privilege of free pickle ball participation just as they do, for example, with free State Park admission. Many of us enjoy pickle ball on a daily basis as it is available. At the current fee of \$3.00 per session, it can become a very costly sport for seniors over 65.

The Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee will be meeting this coming Thursday, October 18, at 5 p.m. in the City-Wide Community Center. I intend to present the committee with this proposal at that time. Thank you in advance for your consideration in this matter.
