RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, BY WAY OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT, TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF SAFETY, STATE HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT EXERCISE AND EVALUATION PROGRAM, FOR GRANT FUNDING OF A HOMELAND SECURITY EXERCISE IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE MERRIMACK VALLEY SCHOOL DISTRICT

The City of Concord resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, the Concord Police Department desires to apply for grant funding through the Department of Safety Homeland Security and Emergency Management Exercise and Evaluation Program to conduct a Homeland Security Exercise in partnership with the Merrimack Valley School District; and

WHEREAS, the Concord Police Department participates in training for critical incidents with the Merrimack Valley School District; and

WHEREAS, the Concord Police Department and Merrimack Valley School District desire to utilize this exercise to assess the emergency response to such an incident; and

WHEREAS, there is funding available and the City of Concord is eligible to receive funding through the Department of Safety Homeland Security and Emergency Management Exercise and Evaluation Program to conduct such an exercise; and

WHEREAS, there is no financial match required for this grant program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of City of Concord that:

1. The City Council authorizes the City Manager to submit the necessary grant application documents.
2. This resolution shall take effect upon its passage.
