RESOLUTION FIXING AND DETERMINING THE AMOUNT OF MONEY TO BE APPROPRIATED BY THE CITY OF CONCORD FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2023 ENDING JUNE 30, 2023 FOR THE GENERAL FUND, SPECIAL REVENUE FUNDS, ENTERPRISE FUNDS, DEBT SERVICE FUNDS AND DE MINIMIS ACCOUNTS

WHEREAS, the proposed fiscal year 2023 budget as provided and summarized below; and

WHEREAS, the fiscal year 2023 budget provides for the operations, maintenance, improvements, payment of debt service, and transfers; and

WHEREAS, Section 34 of the City Charter requires the City Manager to submit the proposed budget to the City Council at least forty-five (45) days before the start of the fiscal year of the budget;
