**RESOLUTION** ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF SEVENTY FOUR THOUSAND, SIX HUNDRED EIGHTY-SIX DOLLARS AND THIRTY CENTS (\$74,686.30) IN GRANT FUNDING FROM THE NEW HAMPSHIRE DEPARTMENT OF SAFETY - LAW ENFORCEMENT OPIOID ABUSE REDUCTION INITIATIVE, FUNDS DESIGNATED FOR CONDUCTING ILLEGAL DRUG RELATED INVESTIGATIONS.

*The City of Concord resolves as follows:*

**WHEREAS,** the Concord Police Department has received notification from the New Hampshire Department of Safety – Law Enforcement Opioid Abuse Reduction Initiative that the City of Concord has been approved to receive funding in the amount of \$74,686.30 designated to cover overtime costs associated with implementing enhanced strategies focused on addressing the illegal drug/opioid crisis facing the City; and

**WHEREAS,** the Concord City Council approved Resolution #8943, adopted September 12, 2016, at their regular meeting authorizing the City Manager to apply for the above grant; and

**WHEREAS,** the Concord Police Department desires to utilize this funding to cover overtime costs associated with augmenting the Department’s efforts in combatting the illegal drug/opioid crisis facing the City and surrounding communities; and

**WHEREAS,** there is no financial match required for this grant program; and

**WHEREAS,** this appropriation is for a purpose not included in the adopted budget, therefore Section 37 of the City Charter requires a two-thirds vote of the City Council.

***NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Concord that:***

1. The sum of .....\$74,686.30  
be and is hereby appropriated as follows:

Miscellaneous Special Revenue Fund  
Police Overtime and Benefits.....\$74,686.30

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2. Funding to meet said appropriation shall be provided from the following source(s):
