

# CITY OF CONCORD

**RESOLUTION**      AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A TRAFFIC SIGNAL MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT WITH THE NEW HAMPSHIRE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (NHDOT) FOR THE COORDINATED TRAFFIC SIGNAL SYSTEM AT EXIT 13 AND ASSOCIATED INTERSECTIONS

*The City of Concord resolves as follows:*

**WHEREAS,**      the City plans to upgrade the traffic signal management system along the Manchester Street corridor, the system is located on Manchester Street/Water Street/South Main Street/US Route, from the intersection of Old Turnpike Road/Black Hill Road in the east to the intersection with Perley Street/Storrs Street in the west; and,

**WHEREAS,**      the project is funded entirely by the City through funds that were approved in FY 25 under CIP #283 Traffic Signals and Traffic Operations Improvements; and,

**WHEREAS,**      prior to proceeding with the project, the State has requested that the City execute a Traffic Signal Maintenance Agreement, which will formalize the maintenance responsibilities of both parties for the coordinated traffic signal system at Exit 13 and associated intersections.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Concord that:

1.      The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a Traffic Signal Maintenance Agreement NHDOT.
2.      This resolution shall take effect upon its passage.
