The City of Concord resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, the Concord Police Department in conjunction with the Merrimack Valley School

District desires to apply for grant funding through the US Department of

Homeland Security Federal Fiscal Year 2015 Homeland Security Grant Program;

WHEREAS, the Merrimack Valley School District desires to upgrade access control and

school security at the Merrimack Valley High School and Merrimack Valley

Middle School; and

Program; and

WHEREAS, there is no financial match required for this grant program.
