RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A MUNICIPAL WORK ZONE AGREEMENT (MWZA) WITH THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (NHDOT) CONCERNING PROPOSED PAVEMENT IMPROVEMENTS ALONG US ROUTE 4 (HOIT ROAD)

The City of Concord resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, the NHDOT is proposing certain pavement improvements along US Route 4 (Hoit Road) in Concord; and,

WHEREAS, the State of New Hampshire is funding the entire project; and,

WHEREAS, prior to proceeding with the project, the State has requested that the City execute a Municipal Work Zone Agreement, which will grant the NHDOT the authority to regulate traffic activity within the project area.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Concord that:

1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a Municipal Work Zone Agreement with the State of New Hampshire Department of Transportation concerning proposed pavement improvements along US Route 4 (Hoit Road) in Concord.
2. This resolution shall take effect on date of passage.
