**SUBJECT:** Change to Non-Ordinance Based Fees, Fines & Penalties

### **Recommendation**

Add the following fees & fines:

- Library of Things (Musical Instruments, Tools, Games, Electronic Devices, etc.) – Replacement Cost: List Price
- Library of Things – Late Fees: \$5.00 per day

### **Background**

The library recently purchased a variety of items (musical instruments, tools, games, electronic devices, etc.) to lend to patrons as part of a “Library of Things” collection. Community members can save money by borrowing these items for a project or event, or by testing them out before deciding whether to buy their own.

Some examples include:

- A guitar, violin, and ukulele
- Light therapy lamps
- A vehicle code reader, soil tester, and metal detector
- Kan Jam (frisbee game) and karaoke machine
- A digital film & slide scanner, handheld GPS unit, and digital microscope

### **Discussion**

These items were purchased after the annual Non-Ordinance Based Fees, Fines & Penalties were updated and the library wants to launch the collection later this year.
