RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF EIGHTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$80,000.00) DESIGNATED FOR CONDUCTING ILLEGAL DRUG RELATED INVESTIGATIONS AND ACCEPTING THE SUM OF EIGHTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$80,000.00) IN GRANT FUNDING FROM THE NEW HAMPSHIRE DEPARTMENT OF SAFETY - LAW ENFORCEMENT SUBSTANCE ABUSE REDUCTION INITIATIVE FOR THIS PURPOSE

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The City of Concord resolves as follows:

- WHEREAS, the Concord Police Department has received notification from the New Hampshire Department of Safety – Law Enforcement Opioid Abuse Reduction Initiative that the City of Concord has been approved to receive funding in the amount of \$80,000.00 designated to cover overtime costs associated with implementing enhanced strategies focused on addressing the illegal drug/opioid crisis facing the City; and
- WHEREAS, the Concord City Council approved the application to apply for funding up to \$83,571.90 June 9, 2025, at their regular meeting, authorizing the City Manager to apply for the above grant; and
- WHEREAS, the Concord Police Department desires to utilize this funding to cover overtime costs associated with augmenting the Department’s efforts in combating the illegal drug/opioid crisis facing the City and surrounding communities; and
- WHEREAS, there is no financial match required for this grant program; and
- WHEREAS, this appropriation is for a purpose for which funding was not included in the Fiscal Year 2026 adopted budget, therefore Section 37 of the City Charter requires a two-thirds vote of the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of City of Concord that:

1. The sum of\$80,000.00
be and is hereby appropriated as follows:
- Grants and Donations Fund
Police Overtime and Benefits\$80,000.00

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2. Revenue to meet said appropriation shall be provided from the following source:

2026 - 2027 Department of Safety - Law Enforcement	
Opioid Abuse Reduction Initiative	\$80,000.00

3. Sums as appropriated shall be expended under the direction of the City Manager.
4. This resolution shall take effect upon its passage.
