RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPLY FOR UP TO \$3 MILLION DOLLARS OF NEW HAMPSHIRE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (NHDOT) CONGESTION MITIGATION AND AIR QUALITY (CMAQ) PROGRAM FUNDS TO SUPPORT THE COST OF DESIGN, PERMITTING, AND CONSTRUCTION OF CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT (CIP) #31, BROADWAY/WEST STREET INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS.

The City of Concord resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, the City of Concord is eligible to apply to the NHDOT Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) Program for funding to support the cost of design, permitting, and construction of Capital Improvement Project (CIP) #31, Broadway/West Street Intersection Improvements (also known as the “McKee Square Intersection.”); and,

WHEREAS, the CMAQ grants require a minimum 80/20 match with a maximum of \$2,400,000 in federal funds; and,

WHEREAS, on May 14, 2012 the City Council accepted the report submitted by the Engineering Services Division recommending the City Council proceed with design and construction of the roundabout option as discussed in the McKee Square Intersection Improvement Study; and,

WHEREAS, the FY2023 CIP Budget, appropriated \$100,000 to update the traffic assessment and conceptual designs for potential intersection improvement alternatives; and,

WHEREAS, the final design is currently scheduled in the CIP for FY2024 with construction to follow in FY2025; and,

WHEREAS, should the City’s application for this purpose be accepted, project funding would be allocated as follows \$2,400,000 (80%) Federal share and \$600,000 (20%) City share; and,

WHEREAS, the City desires to apply for Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Program funds to design, permitting and construction; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Concord that:

- 1) The City Council has authorized the City Manager to submit the necessary grant application to the NHDOT Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Program to support the cost of design, permitting, and construction of Capital Improvement Project (CIP) #31, Broadway/West Street Intersection Improvements.
- 2) This resolution shall take effect upon its passage.
