RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPLY FOR A GRANT FOR UP TO EIGHT THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$8,425) WITH THE NEW HAMPSHIRE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (NHDOT), BUREAU OF AERONAUTICS, FOR THE PURPOSE OF UPDATING THE STORMWATER POLLUTION PREVENTION PLAN (SWPPP) AT THE CONCORD MUNICIPAL AIRPORT.

The City of Concord resolves as follows:

- WHEREAS,** the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) signed and issued the 2021 National Pollution Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Multi-Sector General Permit (MSGP) for industrial stormwater discharges on January 15, 2021; and
- WHEREAS,** the 2021 MSGP will become effective on March 1, 2021 and will replace the 2015 MSGP; and
- WHEREAS,** the airport is a facility that is regulated by this permit for stormwater discharge; and
- WHEREAS,** this grant is administered by the New Hampshire Department of Transportation and is due to the department by April 17, 2021; and
- WHEREAS,** should the City's application for this purpose be accepted, project funding would be allocated as follows \$7,583 (90%) Federal share, \$421 (5%) State and \$421 (5%) City share; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Concord that:

1. The City Council has authorized the City Manager to submit the necessary grant application to the NHDOT, Bureau of Aeronautics.
2. This resolution shall take effect upon its passage.
