Mr. Hardy was recently approached by a library patron who verbally harassed him and challenged him to "go outside." Police were called to resolve the issue. Mr. Hardy would like situations like this to be "dealt with swiftly."

Todd Fabian gave further details about how the incident was handled. Patron is relatively new to the library and being monitored by library staff and is aware of his behavior. Police will be called in future if patron continues behavior. Todd Fabian stated that libraries in Concord, and statewide, are an uptick of unruly patrons.

• Library Director's Report and Monthly Update

Todd returned from PLA conference, will present board with report next month.

City Council to vote on Community Center vote soon.

Library will change hours in June 2016. Currently 8/2/2 monthly schedule. CPL will start 9/3 monthly schedule. July through May library will be open 7 days a week, Library will be closed on Sundays during the summer.

Sandra Michelon, full time library employee will be leaving the CPL in the next few weeks.

Policy Change Inter-Library Loan policy. There were 512 requests in March. Temporary change in out-of-state loan requests from 5 per month to 1 per month, per patron.

Todd is monitoring NH House/Senate for bills and legislation that involves the library and will report to the board when necessary

Beede house update - Washington Street in Penacook. Renovation of the building for use as a library is not financially feasible at this time.

- CPL Foundation Update- Chris Casko attended the March 15 CPL meeting. He gave the CPL a presentation on the activities and meeting of the Board of Trustees. CPLF has produced posters and publicity for the "When Books Went to War" events upcoming. CPL discussed many subcommittees. Chani Marchiselli will attend the next foundation meeting.
