RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR A U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY BROWNFIELD CLEAN UP GRANT FOR THE ABATEMENT OF HAZARDOUS BUILDING MATERIALS ASSOCIATED WITH THE FORMER CONCORD STABLES BUILDING LOCATED AT 111.5 WARREN STREET

The City of Concord resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, hazardous building materials were identified in the historic Concord Stables building during assessments conducted in August 2022; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to renovate the building for future use, which requires abatement of the known hazardous building materials; and

WHEREAS, the project is eligible to apply for up to \$5,000,000 to cover abatement costs through the 2024 US Environmental Protection Agency Brownfields Clean Up Grant, with a final application due in late November 2024; and

WHEREAS, there is no financial match required for this grant program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Concord, that:

- 1) The City Manager is hereby authorized to submit an application to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency for a Brownfield Clean Up Grant for the abatement of hazardous building materials associated with the former Concord Stables building located at 111.5 Warren Street.
- 2) This resolution shall take effect upon passage.
