RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$500,000) FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW SKATEPARK AT KIWANIS RIVERFRONT PARK (CIP #60) AND ACCEPTING THE SUM OF FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$500,000) OF LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUND GRANT FUNDS FOR THE SAME PURPOSE

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The City of Concord resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Year 2025 Capital Improvement Plan recognizes the need for construction of new skatepark at Kiwanis Riverfront Park (CIP #60); and

WHEREAS, City Council authorized the City Manager to apply for the Land and Water Conservation Fund (LWCF) grant on November 13, 2023; and

WHEREAS, City staff has been notified that an LWCF grant in the amount of \$500,000 has been awarded to the City for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, there is a financial match required for this grant of 50%; and

WHEREAS, this resolution is for a purpose for which funding was not included in the Fiscal Year 2025 adopted budget, therefore Section 37 of the City Charter requires a two-thirds vote of the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Concord that:

- 1) The sum of\$500,000
be and is hereby appropriated as follows:

General Capital Project Fund
Kiwanis (Riverfront) Park (CIP #60).....\$500,000

- 2) Revenue to meet said appropriation shall be provided from the following sources:

General Capital Project Fund
Land and Water Conservation Fund grant\$500,000

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- 3) That Thomas J. Aspell, Jr., City Manager, is duly authorized to enter into contracts or agreements on behalf of the City of Concord with the State of New Hampshire, acting by and through the Department of Natural and Cultural Resources, and is further authorized to execute any documents on behalf of this Municipality which may be in his/her judgement desirable or necessary to effect the purpose of this resolution.
- 4) Sums as appropriated shall be expended under the direction of the City Manager.
- 5) Funds from this grant/resolution will not be expended until the matching funds have been secured and authorized by the City Council.
- 6) This resolution shall take effect upon its passage.
