**AN ORDINANCE** amending the CODE OF ORDINANCES; Title II, Traffic Code; Chapter 18, Parking

**The City of Concord ordains as follows:**

**SECTION I:** Amend the CODE OF ORDINANCES; Title II, Traffic Code; Chapter 18, Parking, Article 18-3, Parking Meters, Section 18-3-4, Location of Parking Meters, by amending Schedule X as follows:

**SECTION II:** Amend the CODE OF ORDINANCES; Title II, Traffic Code; Chapter 18, Parking, by amending Article 18-1, Stopping, Standing, and Parking, Section 18-1-24, Parking—Law Enforcement Vehicles, Schedule XXI, to re-establish law enforcement only parking at the following locations:
