The City of Concord resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, the City Council authorized the City Manager on November 14, 2022 to apply for a lead service line inventory grant in the amount up to \$75,000; and

WHEREAS, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) established new regulations in 2022 requiring all water systems throughout the United States to create an inventory of all service line locations, and their respective materials, available and searchable for the public; and

WHEREAS, the General Services Department has identified the information sources to gather the needed data and a plan to gather information on the ones we have limited records for; and

WHEREAS, the New Hampshire Department of Environmental Services grant of up to \$75,000 will help Concord offset the expenses associated with gathering and presenting the data; and

WHEREAS, there is no financial match required for this grant program; and

WHEREAS, this appropriation is for a purpose for which funds are not included in the Fiscal Year 2023 adopted budget, therefore Section 37 of the City Charter requires a two-thirds vote of the City Council to approve this Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Concord that:

- 1) The sum of\$75,000
be and is hereby appropriated as follows:

- 2) Revenue to meet said appropriation shall be provided from the following source:

3) The following four statements are required under the NHDES rules for acceptance of funds:

A. The City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to take such actions as may be necessary to accept funds from the NHDES Lead Service Line Inventory program for the purposes of gathering and presenting an inventory of all lead service line locations and respective materials available and searchable to the public;

B. The City Council hereby accepts the grant.

C. The City Council authorizes raising, appropriating, and expending the sum of up to Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000) through the participation in the NHDES Lead Service Line Inventory Program;

D. The City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute all documents and undertake all actions as may be required to implement this Resolution.

4) Sums as appropriated shall be expended under the direction of the City Manager.

5) This resolution shall take effect upon its passage.
