RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A MUNICIPAL WORK ZONE AGREEMENT (MWZA) WITH THE NEW HAMPSHIRE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (NHDOT) CONCERNING PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS TO INTERSTATE 89 AND NH ROUTE 13

The City of Concord resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, the NH Department of Transportation is proposing certain transportation

improvements at Exit 2 on Interstate 89 and Clinton Street, including signalization of the intersection, as well as improvements to NH Route 13 beginning at Silk Farm Road and ending at the urban compact line in the vicinity of Mandevilla Lane; and,

WHEREAS, the project is funded entirely by the State of New Hampshire; and,

WHEREAS, prior to proceeding with the project, the State has requested that the City execute a

Municipal Work Zone Agreement, which will grant the NHDOT the authority to

regulate traffic activity within the project area.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Concord that:

- 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a Municipal Work Zone Agreement with NHDOT.
- 2. This resolution shall take effect upon its passage.
