

SUBJECT: Conservation Commission Reappointments

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the following appointments be reviewed at the February City Council Meeting for approval in March.

Background:

I hereby propose the reappointment of the following individuals to continue their service on the Conservation Commission, each for an additional three year term, which would expire on January 1, 2019.

- Christopher Morgan would continue to serve as a Regular Member. Mr. Morgan resides on Graham Road and is a retiree of the NH Department of Transportation where he served as Administrator of the Railroads and Public Transportation Division. He currently serves as Chairperson of the Commission.
- Christopher Kane would continue to serve as a Regular Member. Mr. Kane resides on Donovan Street and is a Stewardship Consultant with the Society for the Protection of New Hampshire Forests.
