## **Recommendation**

It is recommended the City Council deauthorize one hundred seventy-seven dollars and twenty-two cents (\$177.22) in grant funding from the New Hampshire Department of Safety – State Homeland Security grant to the Concord Police Department to be used for equipment purchases for police department members on the Central New Hampshire Special Operations Unit.

## **Background**

The Concord City Council approved a report and resolution submitted by the Concord Police Department to accept and appropriate sixteen thousand dollars (\$16,000.00) of grant funding from the New Hampshire Department of Safety – State Homeland Security on January 13, 2025.

The actual grant amount from New Hampshire Department of Safety – State Homeland Security is fifteen thousand eight hundred twenty-two dollars and seventy-eight cents (\$15,822.78) therefore the Concord Police Department is requesting the City Council deauthorize one hundred seventy-seven dollars and twenty-two cents (\$177.22) from the New Hampshire Department of Safety – State Homeland Security grant thereby reducing the total accepted grant amount to fifteen thousand eight hundred twenty-two dollars and seventy-eight cents (\$15,822.78).

## **Discussion**

The Concord Police Department seeks to deauthorize City Council-approved grant funding to comply with New Hampshire Department of Safety – State Homeland Security grant requirements. The deauthorization of funds is necessary for this grant project to move forward.
