PROGRAM

The City of Concord resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, the Concord Police Department desires to apply for funding through the US

Department of Justice, Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS

Office) Community Policing Development Microgrant program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Concord desires to attain a handheld chemical spectrometer used in

the rapid identification of unknown substances in the field, such as fentanyl, its

analogs, and other dangerous substances; and

WHEREAS, grant funding is available to the City of Concord, and the Concord Police

Department is eligible to receive funding through the FY 25 Community Policing Development Microgram program funded through the US Department of Justice

COPS Office.

WHEREAS, there is no financial match required for this grant program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Concord that:

- 1. The City Council authorizes the City Manager to submit the necessary grant application documents.
